Additionally, how would each application be handled and who would have access to the sensitive information. It was decided to continue using the application, which currently asks the question if any member of the household has ever been convicted of a felony

- 3. Reports
 - a. President's Report
 - The Community Service Agreement for Southlake Sister Cities (SSC) is up for renewal. It was originally signed for one (1) year but has been extended for three (3) years September 2015 – September 2018. The Southlake City Council will vote during their September 15th City Council meeting.
 - ii. The Southlake Senior Activity Center has a bus for SSC to use for the China students; however, the driver must be a Southlake employee and their driver recently retired. We will look at other options for transporting the students.
 - b. Community Service staff report
 - i. No action taken at this time
 - c. Treasures Report Andy Chen
 - i. No action taken at this time.
- 4. Wuzong Student Delegation's visit update (9/26/15 10/01/15)
 - a. The Student Delegation consists of 11 students, one (1) teacher and one (1) vice Principal. They are arriving late on Saturday the 26th and leaving early Thursday October 1st. Activities have been planned for the delegation to include US Bureau of Engraving and Printing, Fort Worth Stockyards, a day in the life of a Southlake high school student and an end of the trip party.

- 5. Host Family applications, background check and recognition
 - a. SSC received many applications. First preference goes to students who participated in China program in March 2015 allowing them to host the student they stayed with in March. A waiting list was created with the extra potential host families and a database will be created for future use.
 - b. The SSC has created a PDF fileable application for the host family to complete. The application for the Youth Ambassador trip for Japan and China are also available on the website as a download.
 - c. The Southlake Sister International policy is to have background checks for the host family; however, it is not mandatory. The city of Southlake will currently perform the background checks for volunteers but we still need a third party to monitor the results. We will talk to the city about partnering.
 - d. In recognition for hosting students, SSC will continue to invite the host families to the end of the year dinner/party free of charge.
- 6. Identify quarterly general membership meetings and/or educational/cultural programs
 - a. December's annual meeting (End of the Year party), the Chinese Party and the Tome party will be used as the general membership meetings. We are working on adding two (2) additional cultural programs. Possibly visiting with the Fort Worth Sister City International for their thoughts and/or hosting a presentation on the Chinese stock market.
- 7. Other items for discussion and consideration
 - a. The September 12, 2015 Adopt a Street started at 10:00 am and ended at 11:00. SSC partnered with the Metroport Rotary Club and had approximately 40 14 in attendance.
 - b. Film Festival, 2016 International Culture Festival (ICF): The film festival will be held on May 7, 2016 with APEX taking the lead. SSC will provide judges for the foreign film. The foreign film will be the highlighted film projected on the HD big screen outside once the sun goes down. Details TBD. ICF will be May 21, 2016 and will recognize different cultures. It will be considered the summer kick off. As it is a stand-alone cultural festival, SSC will look at partnering with them and have one 1-2 board members sit on the planning committee. Details TBD.
 - c. New SSC website update: tabled until next month
 - d. Portable projector and screen: We are currently looking at spending an average of \$400 \$500 for a projector and approximately \$100 for the screen. We are looking at what occasions and how often would we utilize them. We will continue to price match before purchasing. Looking at purchasing for the December End of the Year party.

e. End of the Year Dinner Party: Scheduled for December 3, 2015 at 6:00pm. We are hoping to show pictures from both the Tome and Wuzong Youth Ambassador trips during the party. If we set up a drop box account for each trip, individuals could drop their photos in the box and we could easily access them.
